Pastoral Perspectives for May 2024

Grace and peace to you from God the Father of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ in the Holy Spirit.

The church calendar wraps up the important feast days of the church in the merry month of May. Starting with the <u>Ascension of our Lord</u>: where our Lord Jesus returns to His heavenly throne and sits at the right hand of the Father, then <u>Pentecost Sunday</u>: where the Holy Spirit is given to the first disciples and has been handed down throughout time to all church members and, the month ends with <u>Holy Trinity Sunday</u>: where we learn of the Triune God of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

We will confess our faith in the third creed of the church with *The Athanasian Creed* (which is only used on Holy Trinity Sunday) in remembrance of Athanasius (A.D. 293-373) who was the champion of orthodoxy against the heresy that Arius touted against the Holy Trinity.

In our Lutheran Confessions we confess all three creeds: <u>The Apostles Creed</u> for individual confession, <u>The Nicene Creed</u> for a community confession and finally the <u>Athanasian Creed</u>. Only one hymnal, the LBW (green hymnal), contains all three creeds! Someone has literally dropped the Lutheran Confessional ball when it comes to our hymnals over time. These are the kinds of issues we discuss in our catechism classes on Tuesdays mornings and evenings if this interests you!

The church will then move to lesser feast days in the coming months of Spring time and Summer as the world will keep us busy with graduations, vacations, yard work and whatever else is on our calendars.

If life gets a little stressful or too busy remember the church is always open and if you need a top up on your faith in God's Word, the message and amazing hymns that will keep you humming throughout your week please come and worship, in Christ Jesus.
